Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Develop a sense of awe and wonder at the natural world and its creation - Develop an understanding of how science helps us understand the world around us - Develops a sense of laws, order and purpose - Develops an understanding that not all questions can be answered by science - Develops an ability to ponder the relationship between science and faith - Being able to reflect upon how science can help us environmental issues - Develop an understanding of scale – our place in the universe
RE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Develop an understanding about people of faith and those of none (including worldviews) across all traditions and where they sit in relation to this - Develop an ability to ask and respond to 'I wonder' questions - Be able to reflect upon meaning and purpose - Develop an understanding of why people pray - Develop a respect for others - Develop care for others
